## ORDINANCE NO. 1 OF 2020

### ORDINANCE RESTRICTING HUMAN BURIALS TO CEMETERIES

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Board of the Town of Greenbush, Sheboygan County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

That ARTICLE 30 – DEFINITIONS, Definitions of the Town of Greenbush Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended to include the following:

#### BURIAL

Entombment, inurnment, or interment and “bury” means to entomb, inurn or inter.

#### CEMETERY

Any location for the burial of human remains in the town.

#### HUMAN REMAINS

The body of a deceased individual that is any stage of decomposition or has been cremated.


ARTICLE 14 & 19 REGULATIONS AND VIOLATIONS – Use Regulations, is amended to create the following:

F. The burial of human remains on property other than an established cemetery shall be prohibited and shall be a violation of this ordinance. The burial of human remains in the town shall take place only in established cemeteries or sites that have been zoned and granted a conditional use permit to be a cemetery. The spreading of cremated ashes on private property shall not constitute a violation of this provision.
